



# Make your own snow globe from *Lucy's Magic Snow Globe*

You will need an assistant, so make sure that an adult helps you!

## You will need:



Clean jam jar



Glitter



Epoxy resin glue, or any other waterproof glue (available from DIY and craft shops)



White plasticine



Water



Plastic model trees and festive figures (Christmas cake decorations are perfect!)



Glycerin (available from chemists)



A helpful grown up to do some gluing

1. Inside the lid of your jar build a snowy hill from the white plasticine. This will make it easier to see your little figures.
2. Place the figures and trees on the hill.
3. Ask an adult to glue the hill and figures in place for you, and leave to dry for 15 minutes.
4. Fill the jar with water, almost to the very top. Add two teaspoons of glitter, two drops of glycerin, and stir.
5. Screw the lid tightly back on to your jar. Make sure it is on properly, so it does not leak.
6. Turn upside down, gently shake, and watch the snow swirl around!
