

Instructions

The *Read Write Inc.* Comprehension and Grammar tests consist of six papers:

- Children will need to be able to read words with Set 1 and 2 sounds to read papers 1–4.
- Children will need to be able to read words with Set 1, 2 and 3 sounds to read papers 5 and 6.
- Each paper has an accompanying answer key for teachers.

How to administer the tests

Tests can be given individually or in groups.

Ensure that children are sitting separately and cannot see each other's test papers. Each child will need a copy of the test paper, a pencil and a rubber.

Spend five minutes at the start of the test explaining the format.

PART 1: Comprehension tests

(Allow 15-20 minutes for children to complete this section)

1. Show children how to read any 'Challenge Words' and explain the meaning.
2. Tell the children that they need to read through the text first.
3. Show the children how to tick the box next to the correct answer. Explain that it's important that they read all the answers before they tick the one they think is correct.
4. Show the children how to answer the other questions on the writing lines provided.
5. Ask children if they have any questions about the test, then ask them to write their name at the top of the paper.
6. Work through the first question together, if necessary.

Stop the children before they answer Part 2.



PART 2: Grammar tests

(Allow 10 minutes for children to complete this section)

These are not directly related to the text, but draw on the content to help to contextualise the grammar

1. Explain to the children that there are eight grammar questions.
2. Write the first grammar question on the board.
3. Show how you try out each word by saying the sentence out loud to see which one makes sense. Then, when they are happy, they should tick the missing word.
4. Explain each different question type, such as adding punctuation to a sentence and ticking the correct answer within a table.
