



## More than one

1. If you look up **lorry**, you also find **lorries**. **Lorries** is the word for more than one **lorry**.

If a word ends in **-y**, then you change the **-y** at the end to **-ies** to show that there is more than one.

If you look up **monkey**, you also find **monkeys**. **Monkeys** is the word for more than one **monkey**.

If a word ends in **-ey**, then you add **-s** to show that there is more than one.

What is the word for more than one of the following?

2. If you look up **leaf**, you also find **leaves**. **Leaves** is the word for more than one **leaf**.

The **-f** at the end has changed to **-ves** to show that there is more than one.

Be careful! Not all words that end with **-f** change in this way to show that there is more than one. Sometimes, you just need to add **-s**.

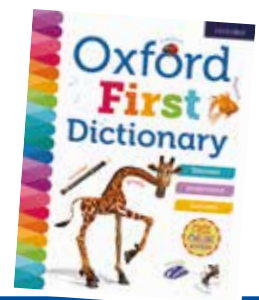
