

# Make a brilliant bird snack skewer!

Follow these steps to make a super snack for the birds in your garden.

Make sure an adult is helping you with this, as some steps are a bit fiddly.

## YOU WILL NEED:

- Floral wire (available from most garden centres and craft shops)
- Bird food (e.g. apple, stale bread, hard cheese, raisins)– check the RSPCA website for other great bird-friendly foods
- String



## Make your skewer

### Step 1

Get the ingredients you want to put on your skewer. Apples, stale bread, hard cheese, and raisins are all great ideas.

### Step 2

Cut your ingredients into small cube-sized pieces. Make sure an adult is doing the cutting and don't use a knife yourself.

### Step 3

Push the fruit, bread, and cheese onto pieces of floral wire, leaving about 10cm of uncovered wire at either end.

### Step 4

Bend the ends of the wire into hooks.

### Step 5

Now bend the wire into a circle, linking the hooked ends together.

### Step 6

Tie a loop of string around your wire skewer circle and hang it outside.

### Step 7

Watch your garden's birds enjoy their lovely skewer snack!
