There are two mixed up sentences here. Work out what they both say and where the spaces between the words should be.

Answer

The letters are alternating between the two sentences so every other letter makes the proper sentence. If you look at the last line you can nearly see the word 'sentences' with each letter written twice. Add in the spaces so that the sentences can be easily read.

To resolve this we need to write out every other letter to make our two sentences. Then we need to work out where the spaces should go to make sense of the sentences.
