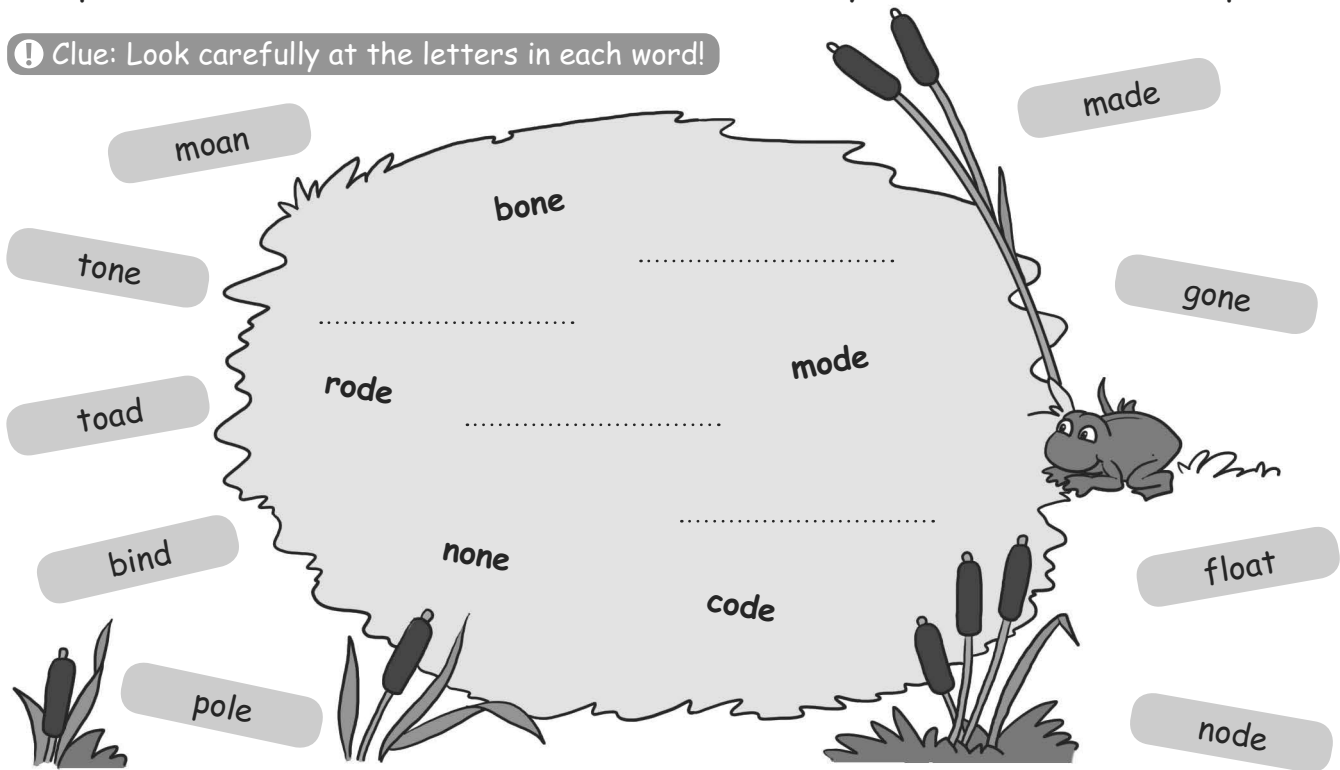


Pond

All the words written in the pond are similar in a special way. Look carefully to see how they are similar. Then look at the words around the pond - which ones are similar in the same way? Write them in the pond.

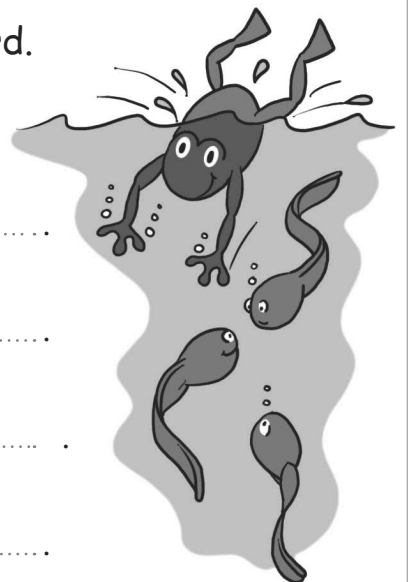

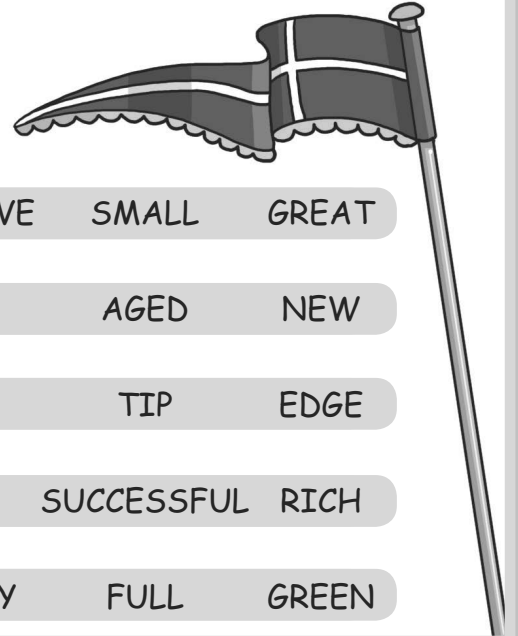

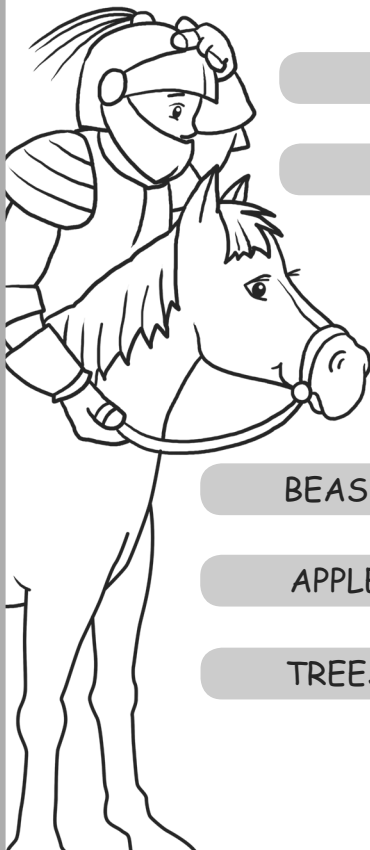
Castles
