



A guide to how the Read Write Inc. Fresh Start Modules and Anthology texts link to the Read Write Inc. Phonics eBooks

If your child is learning to read at school with *Read Write Inc. Fresh Start*, the free resources on Oxford Owl will help them to practise:

- their knowledge of the Speed Sounds
- sound blending
- reading Speedy Green Words
- reading carefully levelled eBooks which follow a similar phonic progression to Fresh Start.

Phonics eBooks

There are 75 [Read Write Inc. Phonics eBooks](#). The chart below shows which eBooks focus on the same Speed Sounds as the Fresh Start Modules and Fresh Start Anthology texts.

For example, if your child is reading Fresh Start Module 4 *Hay into gold* they can read the eBooks *Dragon Bay* at Pink level or *We can play* at Orange level and any of the eBooks before these, as they contain words made up of the Speed Sounds that your child will have learnt.

We recommend your child reads each eBook three times, as they would at school: once to read the words correctly, a second time with more fluency, and a third time in a 'storyteller voice' that shows their understanding.

Although *Read Write Inc. Phonics* and *Fresh Start* follow a similar phonics progression, the texts in the two programmes are not interchangeable. The pace of *Fresh Start* is much faster than the *Phonics* progression. The *Phonics* progression has more review built into it, e.g. at Purple, Orange, and Yellow levels. Hence, this correlation is only a best fit.

The chart shows the closest match to the phonics focus in the Modules and Anthologies texts to the Phonics eBooks. However, there will be differences in the Red Words and Story Green Words practised.
