The words **am**, **is** and **are** help to make lots of **doing words**.

**am** + verb family name + ing

I **am talking**. I **am working**. I **am reading**.

**is** + verb family name + ing

He **is talking**. He **is working**. He **is reading**.

**are** + verb family name + ing

We **are talking**. We **are working**. We **are reading**.
