Trick or treat Isadora Moon style with our vampire-fairy Halloween hunt!



Instructions

- 1. A grown up cuts out the vampire and fairy items on the following pages and hides them around the house before the trick or treating begins!
- 2. Now the fun part... the children need to find as many of the items as they can. For every vampire item they find they get a trick and for every fairy item they find they get a treat!
- 3. A trick could be eating a spooky dragon egg (the recipe is in the party pack on isadoramoon.co.uk) or casting a 'freezing spell' so the children have to stand still for 2 minutes! A treat could be watching an Isadora Moon animation on Instagram at @IsadoraMoon, or drinking some delicious Isadora Moon hot chocolate (the recipe is in the activity section of isadoramoon.co.uk).
- 4. Use our handy table below to count up how many vampire and fairy items the children find.
- 5. Bonus round! Pink rabbit is neither vampire or fairy, but the first child to find him wins a special prize!
