Student Book eBooks	A digital version of each of the six Student Books with hotspots to resources. Can be used for whole-class teaching and also be accessed by students at home. (Student access comes with the Teacher and student access subscription.)	✓	
Workbook eBooks	A digital version of each of the six Workbooks.	✓	
Teacher Guide eBooks	A digital version of each of the six Teacher Guides.	✓

Assessment overview	One PDF per stage showing which learning objectives are assessed by which assessment type (print and digital).	✓	
'in unit' interactive quizzes	Two per unit (to be used during teaching) for <b>formative</b> assessment. Questions linked to the main focus of the unit, including grammar, spelling, vocabulary and punctuation. Answers are auto-marked, but not stored.	✓	✓
'end of unit' interactive quizzes	One per unit (to be used at the end of each unit) for <b>summative</b> assessment. Questions cover the content of the unit and are to be completed independently. Assignable by the teacher. Audio included for Stages 1 and 2. Answers are auto-marked and marks stored for reference.	✓	✓

End-of-unit assessments	One PDF per unit for <b>summative</b> assessment to assess comprehension and writing. Can be completed independently under test conditions, as a classroom activity or given as homework. Assignable by the teacher.	✓	✓
End-of-unit test answers	PDF answers and mark schemes.	✓	
Revise and check assessments	Three PDFs per stage to assess grammar, vocabulary spelling and punctuation. Questions cover the content of 3 units. Can be completed independently under test conditions, as a classroom activity or given as homework. Assignable by the teacher.	✓	
Revise and check answers	PDF answers and mark schemes.	✓	
Progress assessment charts	PDF checklist (one per stage) to track individual students to ensure learning objectives have been achieved.	✓
